Event Attendance / Safety Guidance

The Virginia Chamber will be working with the Greater Richmond Convention Center to ensure that enhanced health and safety measures are in place to protect those who attend. Vaccinated guests are welcome to join us in-person and the event will have a limited capacity (less than 400 attendees) in order to follow social distancing recommendations. The morning general session will be set theater style and attendees will be asked to skip one seat between one another. The luncheon program will be set in rounds with no more than five people per round table.

We will continue to offer a “Virtual Conference Registration” option for those that are not ready/able to join us in person. Those who are not fully vaccinated are encouraged to register to participate virtually or, if choosing to participate in-person, will be required to wear a mask at all times when not actively eating or drinking. To protect the health and well-being of those in attendance, we encourage all attendees to wear a mask regardless of vaccination status, if they are willing.

Terms of Agreement for Participating In-Person

By registering to attend the event in-person, the attendee:

- Agrees that they have been fully vaccinated in advance of the event
- Or, If not fully vaccinated, agrees to wear a mask at all times when not actively eating or drinking
- Voluntarily assumes all risks related to exposure to COVID-19, and the Virginia Chamber disclaims any and all liability related thereto

In accordance with the guidance and recommendations set forth by the CDC and local health officials, we respectfully request that the following guests not attend an event:

- Guests who are feeling sick or experiencing cold or flu-like symptoms (including fever, cough, and shortness of breath);

- Guests who have been diagnosed with, or believe to have contracted, COVID-19, unless you have had no fever for 72 hours (without use of medicine) and 10 days have passed since symptoms first appeared;
- Guests who have been in contact with an individual diagnosed with COVID-19 within the past 14 days.

** The Virginia Chamber will follow all federal and state guidelines for hosting this event. These guidelines are subject to change due to the continually changing circumstances and will be updated accordingly.*
